DAY 1 - MARCH 13, 2024	
Plenary Session I Substance Use in the CMV Industry: Trends and Contributing Factors	This session will provide an overview of the FMCSA Drug and Alcohol Clearinghouse, current trends in drug violations, and factors that may contribute to substance use among CMV drivers.
Plenary Session II Reasonable Suspicion and CMV Drug Testing	This session will review the physical, mental, and performance-related indicators of substance use among CMV drivers. Drug testing methodologies, including hair and oral testing, will be discussed, as well as the impact of cannabis legalization on the CMV industry.
Breakout Session (Industry) Addressing CMV Driver Substance Use and Compliance	During this session, fleet safety leaders will have the opportunity to engage in open discussion with peers, reflect on substance-related challenges within their fleet, and identify potential solutions to promote compliance.
Breakout Session (Law/Government) Strategies to Support Fleets and Promote Compliance	During this session, CMV stakeholders will discuss ways to support fleets in their efforts to reduce and prevent substance use.
Concurrent Session Developing and Enhancing Substance Policies (Part 382)	This session will review key considerations when developing and/or enhancing fleet policies regarding substance use and compliance, as well as differences in DOT versus non-DOT policies.
Concurrent Session Creating a Culture of Wellness for CMV Drivers	This session will provide examples of fleet wellness programs and discuss their impact on employee satisfaction and driver retention.
